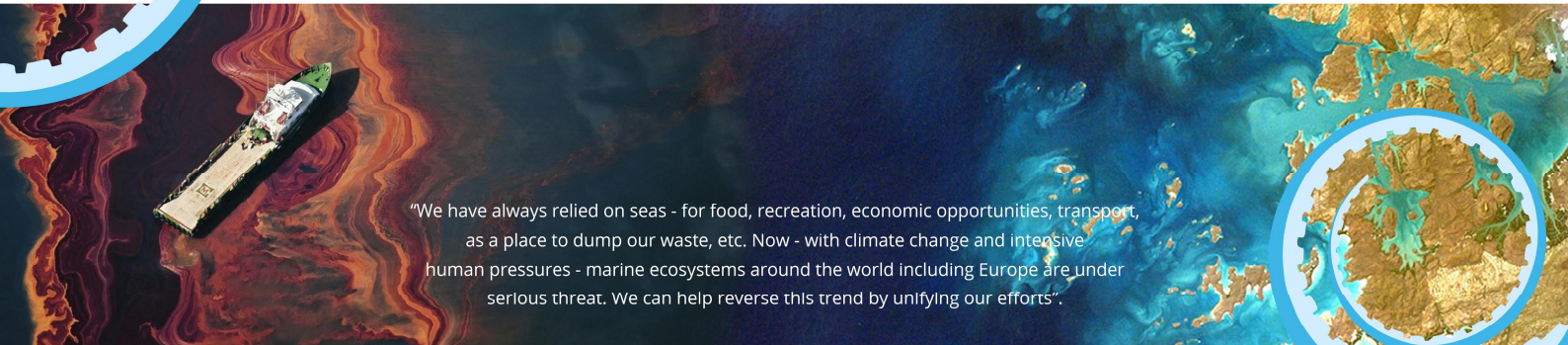




Get started in responsible marine research and innovation.
