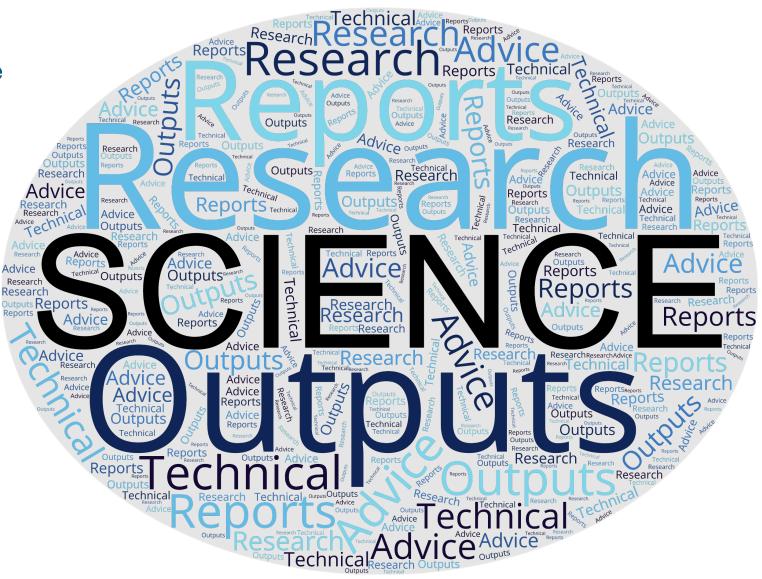

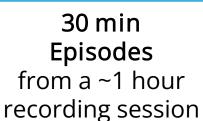

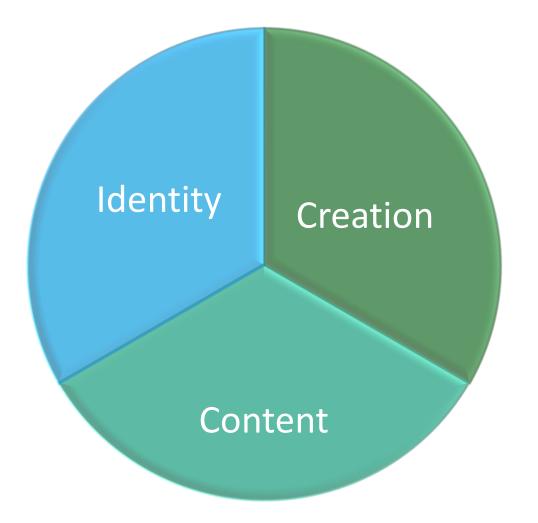
UNIQUE - Where is there a gap?

RELEASE – channels/platforms, subscription?, availability, sharing

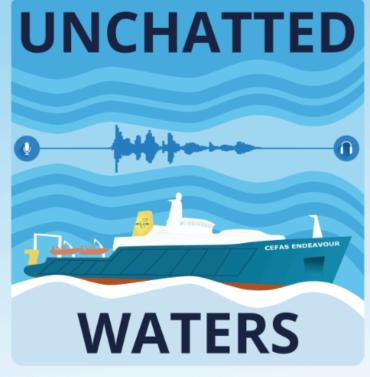
EVALUATE – engagement metrics, listens, ratings
